POSITIVE PATHWAYS

Positive Pathways helps young people who are vulnerable and most at risk of:

Being involved in or at risk of becoming involved in crime and ASB

Associating with people who are involved in crime and ASB

Presenting challenging behaviour in the community

Struggling with personal or circumstantial issues associated with crime and ASB, including carrying a weapon, alcohol and substance misuse

A Youth Worker will engage with young people to:

- **Identify the young person's concerns, issues and needs.**
- **Develop an action plan which responds to the identified needs.**
- **Consider and identify local services which may be best placed to provide support.**
- **Work on potential barriers to actively broker the young person to other YCH Services for Young People projects and signpost to other services and positive activities.**
- **Support the young person in achieving positive outcomes.**
